

Development Partnerships in Jigawa State

In its effort to fast-track the socioeconomic development of the state, the State Government has over the years cultivated and harnessed relationship with various development partners. This is in the spirit of Goal No. 8 of the Millennium Development Goals which seek to promote “global partnership for development”. For Jigawa State, the primary objective in developing these partnerships is to source technical assistance and development grants in various sectors. As of 2007, the only major Development Partners was the UK Department for International Development [DFID] funding some few programmes majorly including State and Local Government Programme (SLGP) and Partnership for Transforming Health Systems. Over the years, political commitment to institutional and governance reforms and improved service delivery targeted towards the attainment of the MDGs as well as the existence a comprehensive development framework guiding the State development process, has engendered partnerships with various Development Partners in the State. The UK Department for International Development [DFID] alone has expanded its programme portfolio four programmes in 2007 to about 17 in 2014. A rubdown of current portfolio of the various Development Partners and their respective programmes is given as follows.
